In our home hangs a small sign that reads: "God will heal your broken heart if you will give him all the pieces." The story behind this gift lives on in my heart. It was 15 years ago late one night when

our phone rang. That wasn't unusual. As an RN and Catholic counselor I had served women in crisis pregnancy as well as through the painful aftermath of abortion. Many had access to our home phone number.

This call was different.

A faithful Catholic pediatrician was on the other

line, accompanied by the parish priest. In the background I could hear a woman screaming, "I hate this monster! I hate priests! I hate the Church! I don't want this 'thing'! Leave me alone! I hate all of you!"

"Linda" was greatly struggling with knowledge that the life growing within her was extremely deformed due to a genetic birth defect. Her husband "Mike" had been going from parish to parish knocking on doors, desperately seeking a priest who might encourage Linda to cancel a 2nd trimester abortion. All other doors closed, at this parish God intervened. The M.D. asked if I would see Linda in my office the next morning, if she would agree.

The following morning a distraught, young woman with a small boy in tow arrived in my office. Arms crossed, she was filled with determination and rage. As we entered my office I glanced at the crucifix over the door and knew this session was beyond my competence. I placed her in the Heart of Jesus.

Linda's rage spoke, but so did her tears. She shouted how she would not bring a "monster" into the world. In that moment I was moved to direct her attention to her young boy, "Sam," who was ever so slightly dismantling my office. I asked if he were diagnosed with a terminal illness, would she love him in his moments of pain and discomfort, his deteriorating condition, his need for her. Linda became quiet and looked at Sam with tenderness: "Of course, I would love him with all my heart and be there for his every need." She became quiet.

I sensed the graces of the Holy Spirit moving us into a blessed space. We were able to gently share the story of another young pregnant mother who was alone, possibly frightened and uncertain of what the future would bring. And how that young pregnant

woman traveled to visit an older woman sort of like us this morning. And when they went to present their infant for blessing they were told that this journey would entail great sorrow.

At that moment Linda said, "I know about that woman... wasn't her

name 'Mary'?" She was able to enter into my recounting the

experience of Mary holding the bruised and broken body of her Son when he was removed from the Cross, to ponder what that must have been like.

Aware that her heart was softened, I was moved to pronounce: "He freely did this for you, Linda. His Mother deeply

Now there were different tears in her eyes. A new relationship was

born. Linda allowed me to give her a rosary and a small booklet.

She agreed to come for another session before her scheduled

appointment to abort her baby.

When she returned the following week, she allowed me to pray with her at the start of our session. I led her through an experience of gifting her unborn son with prayers, letters, and expressions of love. Linda truly did begin to fall in love with her baby. She named him "Phoenix" because it meant "out of the ashes."

Prior to the baby's birth, Linda invited the doctor, the priest and me into the post delivery room. These were the same men she had


